Incised penetrating wound 3.5×1.5 cm. on the front of left breast 3 cm. inner to nipple and 10 cms. below sternal notch. Both ends of the wound were sharply cut. Her BP was 40/30 mm. of Hg. While making resuscitative measures she succumbed to her injury. Postmortem examination revealed perforating injury involving pericardium (3×1.4 cm.), right ventricle (2.75×1.2 cm.), left ventricle (2×1 cm.) lower lobe of left lung. (1.75×0.9 cm.). The wound was directed downwards, backwards and to the left for a total minimum depth of 7.5 cms. The left and right chest cavities contained 750 ml. of fluid blood with 850 gms. of blood clot. All organs were pale.
